### Instructions:

- Go to EASE History -- <http://www.easehistory.org/>
- Search on 'War and your assigned decade in EASE History's Advanced Theme Search. [Search: EASE History Home Page>Theme Search]
- Examine cases that have been coded on 'War' and on your assigned decade. (In EASE History, campaign ads and historical events are treated as cases.)
- Column 1: Select three cases that are a good match with the dictionary entry provided in Column 2. Write the names of the three matching cases in Column 1.
- Column 2: Dictionary entries for 'War' are provided.
- Column 3: The first two columns reveal how the cases are sort of similar to each other. In Column 3, briefly explain, in 2 to 3 sentences, how the three matching cases in Column 1 are sort of different from each other.

After completing the task, groups will share their findings with the whole class.

n 1: the waging of armed conflict against an enemy; "thousands of people were killed in the war" [syn: warfare] 2: a legal state created by a declaration of war and ended by official declaration during which the international rules of war apply; "war was declared in November but actual fighting did not begin until the following spring" [syn: state of war] [ant: peace] 3: an active struggle between competing entities; "a price war"; "a war of wits"; "diplomatic warfare" [syn: warfare] 4: a concerted campaign to end something that is injurious; "the war on poverty"; "the war against crime" v : make or wage war [ant: make peace]
